



For Organizations: Registering for the *Give A Day. Get A Disney Day.* program

About the Program

In 2010, HandsOn Network and Disney Parks are celebrating the good things people do for their communities. We're inspiring one million people to volunteer a day of service and celebrating their good works by giving each of them one day admission to a theme park at *Disneyland*[®] Resort or *Walt Disney World*[®] Resort, free.

This volunteer has approached you for assistance because they were not able to find a *Give A Day. Get A Disney Day.* activity in their community through the national database of opportunities located on www.DisneyParks.com. HandsOn Network has presented them with the opportunity to self manage a project so that they still have an opportunity for free admission to Disney. Your organization can help them by verifying completion of the service opportunity identified in this toolkit.

How Your Organization Can Participate

If you agree to help the volunteer, you must register for the *Give A Day. Get A Disney Day.* program through the HandsOn Network to ensure the volunteer receives his/her ticket. Benefits of participating in this program include:

- Ability to add your existing volunteer opportunities to our national database. Anyone who signs up for these opportunities through www.DisneyParks.com will be eligible for free park tickets.
- Raise awareness of your organization and attract new, committed volunteers that are ready to serve.
- Thanking existing volunteers in a big way.

Even if your organization doesn't typically utilize volunteers, you can still participate by being available to verify self-organized service. Your organization will appear in the search results on www.DisneyParks.com when volunteers search for opportunities and agencies within your area.

Some requirements for the program include:

- Organizations must register for the program at <http://VOP.HandsOnNetwork.org>.
- Volunteer events with set dates and times must be entered into the system at <http://VOP.HandsOnNetwork.org>. Or, for opportunities with flexible scheduling, you can make arrangements directly with the volunteers who contact you. The volunteer will then register the volunteer activity you have agreed upon into the system, and identify you as the verifying organization.
- Organizations must verify service within 72 hours of the "commit date" that you and the volunteer agree upon.

Next Steps

1. Trade contact information with the volunteer. When you register, there will be a field to enter the volunteer's e-mail address so they can be notified once your organization completes the registration process.
2. Register with HandsOn Network at <http://VOP.HandsOnNetwork.org>. It may take up to one week to receive confirmation that your organization has been approved to participate in the program.
3. Your confirmation e-mail will contain links to ideas for self-organized projects. Review these options to determine which projects fit with your organizational mission, and whether you will be able to verify the activity and accept any donations of backpacks, baskets, etc. Save the project ideas you choose so that you can share them with the volunteer.
4. Get in touch with the volunteer and determine which project they will complete and when they will complete their service.
